Background Check Information Sheet

(All information on this sheet is secured and protected)

According to Mountain View Community Church’s Code of Conduct, there are common expectations for all paid Staff members and lay leadership. In this day, as a wise precaution, background checks are unfortunately necessary for those involved in service with young people. A pertinent section of the Code of Conduct follows:

5.3.1 Conduct in the Presence of Children and Young People:

It shall be the purpose and intent of all Staff and Ministry Leaders to insure a safe environment for all children and young people. As such, the following conduct and rules shall be enforced.

1. Only Youth Ministry designated Stewards who have had a church designated background check or the child’s immediate family may be overnight guests on trips or events in which overnight stay is done. Only clergy, seminarians and the child’s immediate family members may be admitted to personal living spaces...
3. Planned, ongoing meetings with a child will not take place without the knowledge of a parent or guardian.
 - If one-on-one pastoral care of a minor should be necessary, avoid meeting in isolated environments. Schedule meetings at times and use locations that create accountability.
 - Adults should not be alone with a child in a sleeping facility, locker room, restroom, dressing facility, or other closed room or isolated area that is inappropriate to a ministry relationship.
 - Limit both the length and number of sessions, and make appropriate referrals.
